

COVID-19 Information

After COVID-19 testing and during at least the last five days before the assessment, your loved one should quarantine at home and review the symptom list below daily. If the answer is 'yes' to any of the symptoms, please call the Center.

COVID-19 symptoms:

- a new fever (100.0 or higher)
- new shortness of breath that you cannot attribute to another health condition
- a new cough that you cannot attribute to another health condition
- new muscle aches that you cannot attribute to another health condition or a specific activity (such as exercise)
- new sore throat that you cannot attribute to another health condition
- chills
- repeated shaking with chills
- headache
- new loss of taste or smell
- pain or pressure in the chest
- new confusion or difficulty awakening
- blue-tinged lips or face
- gastrointestinal distress
- recent increase in lethargy
- dizziness or increase in falls
- contact with someone who has suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection within the last 14 days
- runny nose or congestion
