

Who is Eligible?

Among the challenges of our participants they commonly:

- Are frail and/or impaired
- Have varying degrees of Alzheimer's disease or forms of dementia
- Are stroke patients
- Have Parkinson's disease
- Cannot be left alone unsupervised
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Require supervision with daily medications
- Will benefit from a safe and secure environment in a warm and encouraging setting

Rates:

Monday - Friday: full-time, \$71 per day, \$355 per week

3-4 days per week: \$73 per day, \$219 per week (3), \$292 per week (4)

2 days per week (minimum required): \$75 per day, \$150 per week

Financial Assistance may be available.
